Proposition 65 Compliance Statement

California’s Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (officially known as Proposition 65, or Prop 65), was enacted as a ballot initiative in November 1986. The proposition protects the state's drinking water sources from being contaminated with chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and requires businesses to inform Californians about exposure to such chemicals. In line with Proposition 65, California’s Office of Environmental Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) maintains a list of chemicals known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity, which can be accessed on their website <https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/chemicals>

This letter is to confirm that the product(s) listed below have been evaluated according to California’s Prop 65 requirements.
